On April 3, 2018, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), pursuant to 23 U.S.C. § 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated December 14, 2016, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and FDOT, granted Location and Design Concept Acceptance (LDCA) for the I-95/SR 9 Interchange at 6th Avenue South PD&E Study from north of 12th Avenue South to south of Lake Worth Road along I-95/SR 9 and from Michigan Avenue to South C Street on 6th Avenue South. The proposed improvements consist of providing additional capacity to meet existing and future traffic needs; improving safety by alleviating existing roadway and capacity deficiencies; and allowing opportunities for pedestrian, bicycle and transit facilities.
